As reviewed with you at your Intake appointment with one of our clinical staff, this folder will provide you with information and resources you will find helpful throughout your pregnancy. As you read through this folder, we ask that you pay special attention to the **Telephone Information sheet**. This sheet will help you understand how to contact us during and after office hours, how your calls will be triaged and when you can expect a call back.

Please take notice of the **Common Pregnancy Questions** sheets. We have put together this information to provide answers to frequently asked questions in pregnancy. Please read these sheets thoroughly as you will find that many of your questions will be answered here, and you can refer to it throughout your pregnancy.

To build a relationship where you feel most comfortable to share your concerns, we suggest you choose a **Primary Obstetrician** with whom you will see for most of your prenatal visits. Because your primary obstetrician may not be on call the day you have your baby, we also recommend meeting the other care providers in our office at some point in your pregnancy.

As with many obstetrical practices, there are other physicians that are occasionally a part of our obstetrical rotation, covering some nights and weekends. These physicians are established with the Newton Wellesley community and have always provided wonderful care to our patients.
